

## **MAXATAWNY TOWNSHIP SEWAGE PUMPING CYCLES**

As mandated by the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act 537, the Township is required to provide for adequate sewage treatment facilities and for the protection of the public health by preventing the discharge of untreated or inadequately treated sewage. The Official Sewage Facilities Plan for Maxatawny Township indicates that it is necessary to formulate and implement a sewage management program to effectively prevent and abate water pollution and hazards to the public health caused by improper treatment and disposal of sewage. To this end, the Township has adopted a mandatory sewage-pumping schedule, which requires all on-lot systems to be pumped every three years. Systems are required to be pumped according to the last digit of their address, as follows.

**Cycle 1** – addresses ending in the digits 0, 1, or 2 must be pumped by **06/30/2025, 2028, 2031.**

**Cycle 2** – addresses ending in the digits 3, 4, or 5 must be pumped by **06/30/2023, 2026, 2029.**

**Cycle 3** – addresses ending in the digits 6, 7, 8, or 9 must be pumped by **06/30/2024, 2027, 2030.**
